

Words of Comfort for Troubled Hearts – Part III

John 14:12-24

INTRO:

THE SCENE:

Jesus continues with the fourth comforting truth for a troubled heart in **verses 12-14**.

John 14:12-14, *“Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and **greater works than these will he do**, because I am going to the Father. ¹³ Whatever you ask in my name, **this I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son**. ¹⁴ If you ask me anything in my name, I will do it.”*

Fifth divine truth of comfort and hope for the troubled heart.

John 14:15, *“If you love me, you will keep my commandments. ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and **he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, ¹⁷ even the Spirit of truth**, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. **You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.**”*

2 Corinthians 1: 20-22, *“For all the promises of God find their Yes in him. That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to God for his glory. ²¹ And it is God who*

establishes us with you in Christ, and has anointed us, ²² and who has also put his seal on us and given us his Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.”

Ephesians 1:13-14, “In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴ who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.”

John 14:18, “I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. ¹⁹ Yet a little while and the world will see me no more, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live. ²⁰ In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you.”

Well the sixth comfort is in **verses 21-24**

14:21, Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him. ²² Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, “Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself to us, and not to the world?” ²³ Jesus answered him, “If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. ²⁴ Whoever does not love me does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not mine but the Father’s who sent me.”
